

A Global Community



A Typical Day of Learning and Discovery



9am

Morning class begins with an inspirational guest speaker or member of our exceptional faculty introducing an essential subject topic. Older students will attend lectures during this session, and our younger groups will engage in focused learning. Our teaching approach incorporates a range of modern and effective teaching methods, and plenty of opportunities to try out new skills.

11am

The second lesson of the day aims to motivate students and help them explore key themes and issues, going deeper into the subject and encouraging creative thinking, debate and sharing of views.

12:30pm

Lunchtime! Students can enjoy a leisurely lunch with friends or take a walk around campus in the sunshine. Older students can venture out to explore cafés and unique eateries.



1:30pm

Back to the classroom for a practical workshop, or for some time to work on group projects. Students will get hands on in their field of study, from prepping for a mock trial, clinical skills workshops, all the way to researching for a new business proposal.

3pm

Wherever the student is attending an Oxford Royale course, there will be plenty of choice of activities, or chances to enrich their academic experience through practical sessions or project work. Perhaps they'll take a tour of a university college, discover famous filming locations, visit a museum, soak up some culture or take part in sports and leisure activities.

6pm

7pm




Unwind and foster friendships

Astronaut and Scientist

Helen Sharman is the first British Astronaut. In May 1991, she spent eight days orbiting the Earth, living and working on the MIR Space Station. Helen enthuses her audience about Space and the wonders of science, describing the meticulous training and preparation, learning Russian, the space experience, launch and landing, and adjusting to life back on Earth. Awarded the OBE in 1993, Helen is a full-time scientist, a pioneer and a role model and inspiration for people of all ages.

Kriti Sharma is an Artificial Intelligence expert and a leading global voice on ethical technology and its impact on society. Having worked for a number of FTSE 100 companies advising on AI, she now focuses on AI for Social Good, leading projects for social causes, from productivity to inequality, in over 25 countries. Kriti was included in the Forbes 30 Under 30 for advancements in AI and the Recode 100 List of Key Influencers in Technology in 2017.

Mathematician, author and broadcaster

Marcus du Sautoy is the Charles Simonyi Professor for the Public Understanding of Science, and Professor of Mathematics at the University of Oxford. His best-selling books include *The Creativity Code: How AI Is Learning to Write, Paint and Think*, and his BBC broadcasts include *The Secret Rules of Modern Living: Algorithms*. As one of the UK's leading scientists, his fascinating speaking topics include *The Secret of the Winning Streak: The Story of Maths and Why Beckham Chose the 23 Shirt*.

MEng: Imperial College London

Thibaut attended an Oxford Royale summer school in 2015, where he enjoyed experiencing a different style of education and came to understand what was needed for him to get a place at a top UK university. He gained a degree in materials engineering at Imperial College London and rapidly went on to co-found his own company, creating innovative packaging from sustainable materials.

“My Oxford Royale course really confirmed my belief that I wanted to go to university in the UK and helped me to understand what I needed to do to get there. This decision, and studying at Oxford Royale, has been the foundation for my career; I gained a degree in Engineering from Imperial College London and then jointly founded a company. We’re developing a new edible, biodegradable material based on seaweed that is set to revolutionise the packaging industry.

Courses for 13 to 15 Year Olds

At an Oxford Royale summer school for 13 to 15 year olds, bright young individuals embark on a remarkable transformative journey of cultural exchange, academic enrichment and personal growth. Often travelling abroad on their own for the first time, our youngest participants grow in confidence and establish their independence in an international environment. To maximise this unique opportunity for growth, they are supported all the way by our academic and pastoral staff.

Meeting peers from across the world, our younger learners forge global connections and create lifelong friendships. Through guided debate and exchange of ideas, they embrace the richness of different cultures and gain fresh perspectives. 
We require payment of the relevant deposit at the time of booking. A credit or debit card payment is preferred, but other options are available on request.
